The **excellent indoor facilities** offers a splendid museum with film theatre for the whole family. ### Show Terms and Conditions

PLEASE DO NOT LIGHT FIRES OR BARBEQUES (EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED AREAS).  
DO NOT LEAVE VALUABLES UNATTENDED.

- 1) Display Vehicles should be in position by 10:00 (gates open 08:00) on Sunday and should not normally leave before 16:00.
- 2) Vehicle Passes are for Display Vehicles, i.e. an Old Ford, if you are bringing your Display Vehicle on a trailer you will need an Event Support Vehicle pass. Please answer Yes to Trailer question to receive one of these. Once the Display Vehicle has been unloaded the Event Support Vehicle and trailer must leave the arena and park at the top of the site (behind the control building). Please note that vehicles with a disabled badges, are also not allowed on the arena (unless they are a display vehicle), they should be parked in the appropriate disabled parking area.
- 3) Un-restored vehicles may be permitted (at the organisers discretion) by prior acceptance. Such vehicles will be trailered to the show and must have the appropriate insurance.
- 4) All vehicles driven to the show must have Road Tax, MOT and at least Third Party Insurance.
- 5) Only vehicles displaying a Vehicle pass will be allowed into the display areas. All other vehicles will be directed to the public parking areas.
- 6) Display locations and movement of Display vehicles are under the control of the show organisers.
- 7) Clubs will select vehicles to parade in the show ring at specified times, (numbers may be restricted to meet time schedules).
- 8) The Centre and grounds are open to the public from 10:00-17:00
- 9) Attendance at the show and camping/caravanning or parking is at your own risk.
- 10) Toilets and showers will be available on site for campers but there will not be any electric hook-ups.
- 11) With exception of guide dogs, we regret that pets are not permitted anywhere in the museum. Pets must be kept on a lead at all times.
- 12) All tickets are non-refundable.
- 13) We regret that we cannot accept responsibility or liability for theft, loss or injury on this site under any circumstances.
